### Notice of Race

2019 Ted Janeway Memorial Regatta  
September 28 & 29, 2019

#### **Organizing Authority:**

Cold Spring Harbor Beach Club (CSHBC) and the Atlantic Class Association (ACA)

#### **1.0 Rules:**

The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 Including the prescriptions of United States Sailing Association, the Rules of the Atlantic Class Association, and this Notice of Race (except as any of these may be modified by the Sailing Instructions). Handheld VHF radios are required. The R/C will broadcast Venue, Course, and Race information on Channel 78.

#### **2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

Eligibility is limited to Atlantic owners in good standing and charter skippers whose charters are in conformance with Class Rules, sailing Atlantic Class yachts which meet Class rules and certification requirements, and who have completed accepted entries. Participating yachts must be covered by a current liability insurance policy of at least \$300,000. Qualified yachts may enter by completing an entry form (available on line at ) and submitting it as indicated on the form. The deadline for entry is Sunday, September 22, 2019.

#### **3.0 FEES:**

The Entry Fee is \$200, which includes:

- Three championship length races (if time and weather permits)
- Casual dinner gala (BYOL) on Saturday night at CSHBC
- Moorings
- Box Lunch on Sunday
- Breakfast on Sunday

#### **4.0 LAUNCH FACILITIES**

CSHBC has a crane capable of hauling/launching an Atlantic at mid to high tides. Owners will assist with hauling and launching and will do so at their own risk – CSHBC will accept no liability for injury or damage occurring while hauling or launching a boat. The following approximate windows will available this year for launching, but specific arrangements must be scheduled in advance with CSHBC regatta or boathouse staff.

- Thursday, Sep. 26, 2019 7:00 am – 1:00 pm, 7:00 pm – 9 pm
- Friday, Sep. 27, 2019 8:00 am – 2:00 pm
- Sunday, Sep. 29, 2019 9:30 am – 3:30 pm
- Monday, Sep 30, 2019 10:00 am – 4:00 pm

**5.0 HOUSING:**

Housing for visiting crews will be provided on a first-come-first-served basis. Please get housing requests in at least 1 week before the race. Indicate any special requirements, including transportation needs.

**6.0 SCHEDULE:**

Racing will take place on September 28 & 29, 2019.

The first warning will be signaled at 1100 hours on each day of racing.

**7.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Sailing Instructions will be emailed to all entrants by 9/26/2019 .

**8.0 CREW TRANSPORT:**

Visiting crew, not arriving by boat, can be picked up at the Cold Spring Harbor Train Station (Penn Station LIRR, Huntington Line), and brought out with the Race Committee to the Rendezvous: Please coordinate pickup and crew transport with the Beach Club ahead of time.

**9.0 RENDEZVOUS:** At approximately 11:00 AM in the vicinity of Lloyd Point Gong 15. Visiting crews arriving from the Cold Spring Harbor Beach Club can be picked up from the Signal Boat, and visiting tow and support vessels can be anchored in the Sand Hole around the tip of Lloyd Neck. Please coordinate with the R/C on Channel 78 for a pickup.

**10.0 VENUE:**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the approaches to Cold Spring Harbor between 32A and the Lloyd Point Gong 15. If conditions warrant, the Venue may be moved either into Cold Spring Harbor or East of the Lloyd Point Gong. Please follow and keep track of the Signal Boat and monitor Channel 78. First gun at 1100 on September 28, 2019

**11.0 THE COURSES:**

The courses will be windward-leeward for a specified number of legs.

**12.0 RADIO COMMUNICATION:**

The CSHBC Race Committee will be on VHF Channel 78.

**13.0 PRIZES:**

The Ted Janeway series trophy will be awarded for the winner of the series at the Atlantic Class Annual Meeting.
